Notice of Proposed Increase in Pretreatment Surcharge Fees Provided by the South Valley Water Reclamation Facility

The Board of Directors of the South Valley Water Reclamation Facility (SVWRF) will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 16, 2016, at the SVWRF Administrative Office at 7495 South 1300 West, in West Jordan, Utah 84084, to consider a proposed increase in surcharge fees, a lowering of the surcharge trigger points, expanding their Food Service Establishment monitoring program, and charging non-sufficient funds (NSF) fees for returned checks within the area located in Salt Lake County, Utah. Increased fees are proposed for the below designated categories as follows:

PROPOSED FEE INCREASE REGARDING PRETREATMENT DEPARTMENT USER SURCHARGE FEE SCHEDULE:

The Commercial/Industrial Surcharge Fee for Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD) will be \$0.19 for each pound discharged above a concentration of 200 mg/l.

The Commercial/Industrial Surcharge Fee for Total Suspended Solids (TSS) will be \$0.15 for each pound discharged above a concentration of 230 mg/l.

The Commercial/Industrial Surcharge Fee for Total Organic Oils & Grease (Total O&G) will be \$0.26 for each pound discharged above a concentration of 100 mg/l.

If approved the new surcharge fee schedule will go into effect on July 1, 2017.

PROPOSED FEE AND EXPANSION OF FLAT RATE PROGRAM TO INCLUDE ALL FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS

SVWRF is proposing to expand their Food Service Establishment monitoring program to all Food Service Establishments this would include sandwich shops, ice cream/frozen yogurt establishments, bakeries, all commercial kitchens.

PROPOSED FEE ON CHECKS RETURNED FOR NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS

Non-sufficient Funds Fee for returned checks \$25.00 per occurrence.

Except as increased by the Board, all existing fees shall remain the same.

All interested persons appearing will be heard. After considering public comment SVWRF may execute the modifications, revise it, or abandon it.
